

Using GivingPages to raise awareness and remember a loved one

On a cool May morning, Charlene Harrison and her family and friends were preparing for the Steps for Life Walk in Winnipeg, in support of Threads of Life – a national charity that supports family members who have been affected by workplace tragedy. The group was participating in the walk in memory of Charlene's daughter Brittany Murray, who was killed tragically while working as a signal person in a highway construction zone.

There are several reasons why Charlene decided to participate in the Walk. It was a way for her to honour the memory of her vibrant daughter Brittany, raise awareness for workplace health and safety, and raise funds for Threads of Life.

"Threads of Life does very important work, and has helped me and my family a great deal. The money raised through the walk ensures those efforts continue," Charlene explains. Through her GivingPage, Charlene had a place to tell Brittany's story and commemorate her memory, and at the same time, raise funds for the organization that helps families affected by workplace tragedies that she knows all too well. "Fundraising for the walk allowed me to remember Brittany and do my part to prevent workplace tragedies. Everyone should make it home safe from work."




